CANSTRUCTION UPDATE: NEW LOCATION, NEW DATES

Architects' Can-Do Spirit Feeds the Hungry *Construction LA Donates to the Hungry, Raises Awareness*

On Exhibit at 5900 Wilshire Boulevard, October 30th-November 15th

LOS ANGELES—Architects, designers, builders, and engineers will soon create structures meant for feeding, not housing. Instead of bricks, they will use cans of food for the Four Annual Canstruction LA, a design/build contest to be held at 5900 Wilshire Boulevard, directly across from The Los Angeles County Museum of Art. The structures will be on public exhibition from October 30th to November 15th. (Hours: Monday-Sunday 8AM-6PM.)

At the conclusion all cans will be donated to the Los Angeles Regional Foodbank for county-wide distribution to those in need. The public is encouraged to bring additional cans of food as "admission".

A jury of design and culinary experts will judge the structures, naming the Juror's Favorite, Best Use of Labels, Best Meal, and Structural Ingenuity. This year's jury members are Sam Lubell, editor of *The Architect's Newspaper*; John Rivera Sedlar, chef and co-owner of Rivera Restaurant; Wim de Wit, head of the Department of Architecture and Contemporary Art at the Getty Research Institute; and Randall Wilson, environmental design instructor at Art Center College of Design.

"The Foodbank is grateful for the design community's support," said Michael Flood, president and CEO of the Los Angeles Regional Foodbank. "This creative architectural display offers something for the local community to enjoy while they help us end hunger here in Los Angeles."

Canstruction LA is organized by the Society for Design Administration and supported by the American Institute of Architects/Los Angeles.
